O R D E R

Pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7253(g) and consistent with 28 U.S.C. § 2071(b), the United States Court of Veterans Appeals has adopted Rules Governing Complaints of Judicial Misconduct and Disability. While no substantive public comments were received during the announced comment period ending January 22, 1993, the Court has determined that the following substantive changes are necessary:

In Rule 7(a), change "the files of the Clerk" in (7) and "the Clerk's file" in (8) to read "the complaint file".

In Rule 14(f)(5), after the word "necessary", insert the words "and permissible".

In Rule 17(a)(3), delete "(d)".

In Rule 17(a)(4), after the word "If", insert the words ", pursuant to Rule 14(d),".

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that this Court's Rules Governing Complaints of Judicial Misconduct and Disability, as changed above, are hereby adopted effective immediately and applicable to complaints made on or after August 6, 1991, and to all complaints pending in the Court as of that date.
