ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 1(c) of the Court's Rules of Admission and Practice (Rules), the Court created a Standing Panel on Admission and Discipline (Standing Panel), to consider disciplinary cases coming before the Court. Pursuant to a December 23, 2004, Resolution, the Board of Judges resolved that, on August 1st of each year, the Standing Panel's membership shall be redesignated so that "the senior judge of the Standing Panel will be replaced by the judge who is immediately junior to the junior judge then on the Standing Panel." The December 23, 2004, Resolution also provides "[w]hen there is no such judge to join the Standing Panel, then the senior judge on the Court will join the Standing Panel and the rotation order will begin anew."

Accordingly, the Standing Panel will be reconstituted effective August 1, 2010.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, effective August 1, 2010, the Standing Panel will consist of Chief Judge Greene, and Judges Davis and Schoelen.
