**ORDER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Misc. No. 14-11, Senior Judge John J. Farley, III, was recalled, effective September 6, 2011, to perform substantial service to the Court for a period not to exceed 90 days unless extended by the Chief Judge with the consent of Judge Farley, and
