ORDER

The Court, by order dated July 6, 1990, appointed an Admissions Committee to advise the Court on the fitness for practice before it of persons whose applications have been referred to the Committee. The Court has since referred to the Committee, for its consideration and advice, certain applications. Procedures for such consideration are not specified in the Interim General Rules of this Court. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED, <u>sua sponte</u>, that the Admissions Committee, in considering applications for admission to practice which are referred to it, is authorized to solicit and receive from the applicant or from others information which is sought on the application form or which otherwise bears on the applicant's fitness to practice, and to report its findings and recommendations to the Court, simultaneously forwarding a copy to the applicant. It is further

ORDERED, <u>sua sponte</u>, that the Clerk of the Court, upon referral of an application to the Admissions Committee, shall provide notice of such referral, accompanied by a copy of this order, to the applicant.
