IN RE: RECALL OF RETIRED JUDGES

ORDER

Pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1), and in order to meet the needs of the Court, recall-eligible retired judges John J. Farley, III, and Donald L. Ivers, are recalled, each for a period of 90 days, in order to perform substantial service to the Court. The Court requires the service of these recalled judges to assist in reviewing and deciding the unprecedented number of appeals now pending before the Court. Any service beyond the 90-day period must be with the consent of the recalled judge.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, effective September 5, 2006, John J. Farley, III, shall commence service as a judge of the Court for a period of 90 days. It is further

ORDERED that, effective September 11, 2006, Donald L. Ivers shall commence service as a judge of the Court for a period of 90 days.
