IN RE: RECALL OF RETIRED JUDGE

ORDER

Pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1), eligible retired judges of the Court may be recalled by the Chief Judge when further service is needed by the Court. Retired Judge Kenneth B. Kramer, having complied with 38 U.S.C. § 7257, is designated a recall-eligible retired judge. The Chief Judge of the Court has determined that, if recalled, Judge Kramer would provide substantial service necessary to meet the needs of the Court.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, effective February 9, 2016, Judge Kenneth B. Kramer is recalled from retired status in accordance with 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1). When in service, Judge Kramer shall have and exercise all of the judicial powers and duties of the office of a Judge in active service. Judge Kramer shall perform substantial service for the Court in this calendar year as requested by the Chief Judge. He shall serve for a period of time not to exceed 90 days or its equivalent, or for less time should the Chief Judge determine that his service is no longer needed. Only with his consent may Judge Kramer's service be extended this calendar year.
