IN RE: RECALL OF RETIRED JUDGE

ORDER

Pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1), eligible retired Judges of the Court may be recalled by the Chief Judge when further service is needed by the Court. Retired Judge Alan G. Lance, having complied with 38 U.S.C. § 7257, is designated a recall-eligible retired Judge. The Chief Judge of the Court has determined that, if recalled, Judge Lance would provide substantial service necessary to meet the needs of the Court.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, effective June 23, 2025, through December 31, 2025, recall-eligible retired Judge Lance is recalled from retired status in accordance with 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1). Judge Lance shall have and exercise all the judicial powers and duties of the office of a Judge in active service and shall otherwise perform substantial service for the Court as requested by the Chief Judge. It is further

ORDERED that Judge Lance shall serve in recalled status from June 23, 2025, through December 31,2025, to participate in official duties of the Court's Judicial Council in accordance with Rule 5(a) of the Court's Rules Governing Complaints of Judicial Misconduct and Disability, and to perform other substantial service at the request of the Chief Judge and he shall so serve from June 23, 2025, through December 31, 2025, for up to 60 days or its equivalent. With his consent, Judge Lance's service may be extended beyond 60 days.
